Do I have enough defensible space?	NO →	You should leave early	OR You should prepare a defensible space

Have I ember proofed my house?	NO →	You should leave early	OR You should ember proof your home

Do I have enough water?	NO →	You should leave early	OR Install water tanks

Do I have enough fire fighting equipment?	NO →	You should leave early	OR Acquire suitable equipment

Have I identified a Nearby Safer Place (NSP)?	NO →	Identify a suitable Nearby Safer Place (NSP)?	OR You should consider leaving early
YES			
Have I considered the Fire Danger Rating (FDR)?	NO →	You should consider how the FDR will affect your ability to defend	OR Refer to fire.tas.gov.au

Do I have a written bushfire survival plan?	NO →	You should leave early	OR You should create a written bushfire survival plan

<p>If you have answered YES to these questions you could consider staying and defending your property.</p>		<p>If you have answered NO to these questions you may NOT be able to stay and defend your property. It is recommended you leave early.</p>
